

Public Notice – Public Meeting

HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF BELLEVUE

A special resident participation meeting of the Housing Authority of the City of Bellevue (BHA) will be held on Wednesday September 6, 2017 at 4:00 PM. This meeting is a public meeting as defined by Nebraska Legislative Laws.

The meeting will be held at the office of Bellevue Housing Agency at 8214 Armstrong Circle Bellevue, NE 68147.

The meeting will discuss a substantial revision of BHA's Public Housing Authority Plan. In this proposed revision is detailed information as to the Agency's intent to apply for Voluntary Conversion of its public housing stock. Voluntary Conversion means the removal of all of its 49 public housing units from the HUD subsidized public housing program. Doing so will allow BHA to partner with private entities to finance to improve the physical condition of the properties and expand affordable housing options in Sarpy County.

Full details and proposed plans and relocation plans are available at BHA's office and on its website at www.sarpyhousing.org/plans beginning July 19, 2017. Notice of more than 45 days allows for a review and comment period by the impacted parties and public prior to submitting it to the BHA Board of Commissioners for approval. Comments and responses will be incorporated into the final Plans that will be submitted to the BHA Board of Commissioners, City of Bellevue, and Department of Housing and Urban Development.

All interested parties are invited to attend this public meeting at which time you will have an opportunity to be heard regarding the grant application. Testimony will also be accepted at the public hearing scheduled for 4:00 PM on September 6, 2017 at the BHA office at 8214 Armstrong Circle, Bellevue.
